And his grand sire on his dam's side is none other than the great full Accoyo Pperuvian Ganador. Those two males have produced some of the finest Suri alpacas in the country. And their son/grandson, Grand Slam is doing the same. In short, Grand Slam's genetics are rare and exceptional.

He won 1st Place at the AOBA National Show, 1st Place and Reserve Champion at the MAPACA Jubilee, 1st Place and Champion at the PAOBA Breeders' Showcase, 1st Place and Reserve Champion at Alpacapalooza, 1st Place and Champion at the TxOLAN Spectacular, and 1st Place at the Great Western Alpaca Show and the Northwest Alpaca Showcase!

R.A. BUCKSKIN is a 4X Champion - FULL PERUVIAN, $\frac{3}{8}$ ACCOYO, $\frac{5}{8}$ ALIANZA Herdsire sired by the Portland Kidd, with Peruvian Leon, Peruvian Hemingway and PPPeruvian King lineage in his background.

Buckskin is an extraordinary herdsire carrying an extremely dense, high-frequency crimp with an amazing super soft handle. But most importantly, he has retained that Champion fleece quality through the years and is still impressing the Judges. At 6 years, 8 months of age, Buck came out of retirement for the 2009 PAOBA Breeders Showcase, where he was senior to any other alpacas in his class and still won the BLUE RIBBON and then went on to win the RESERVE CHAMPION for the fawn males. The judge asked if Buck's ARI was correct, stating his fleece was superior to the majority of males much younger than him.

Buck's crias are impressive and all show an exceptional improvement over each dam. Conformation, superb fineness and quality fleece coverage is being achieved on each cria. Buck's progeny range in color from white to black and he has even thrown black crias when bred to white and light fawn dams.
