



## 2012 MAPACA JUBILEE Fleece Show Rules ~ Shipping Information

We predict that the fleece show will be a Level III fleece show (175-349 fleeces).

This is a great opportunity to learn how your fleeces rate when judged for 10 individual attributes.

A fleece scorecard accompanies your fleece home.

**Deadline:** All entries must be completed by April 3, 2012. Paperwork must be Postmarked by April 4, 2012

In accordance to the AOBA Rules, the Submission Guidelines are as follows:

- Participants must supply **copy of ARI registration certificate** with each entry.
- Entry fee is \$35 if registration is completed on or before March 18, 2012.
- Late entry fee is \$45 if entry form is registration is completed between March 19 – April 3, 2012
- Breed type: H = huacaya, S = suri
- **Age division at time of shearing:**
  - a) 6 through 12 months (juvenile)
  - b) First birthday through 24 months (yearling)
  - c) Second birthday through 36 months (two-year-old and older)
  - d) Third birthday through 60 months (adult)
  - e) Fifth birthday and older (mature)
- **Length of fiber:**

Minimum fleece length is 3” regardless of age or type of alpaca (huacaya or suri)  
Huacaya: no maximum length for alpacas 12 months or younger.  
Huacaya: 8” maximum for first birthday and older  
Suri: juvenile - minimum 3" to no maximum; yearling – min. 3" to no max.  
Suri: minimum of 3"; 11" maximum for second birthday and older.
- Fleece to be presented in clear plastic, 1mil bag with no labels or writing.
- Match color to ARI color chart and AOBA 2012 show system handbook color definitions.  
Refer to the color legend on the halter show class list.
- Entries shall be limited to a maximum of three entries per breed type, per age division, per color designation (e.g. 3 huacaya juvenile white fleeces).
- 1st through 6th place ribbons awarded.

TO REGISTER:

1. Go to [www.alpacashowreg.com](http://www.alpacashowreg.com) and either create an account or sign in if you already have an account.
2. Once you have chosen the fleeces you are taking and chosen “MAPACA JUBILEE” as your show, please email any fleece questions to [Judy@PerfectPeaceAlpacas.com](mailto:Judy@PerfectPeaceAlpacas.com).
3. Put each of your fleeces into a clear and unmarked plastic bag. Print out your fleece tag from the Registration website and put it in the bag with the fleece.
4. When you check in, you will be given a pick up ticket.

MAIL IN YOUR FLEECE:

5. If you choose to mail in your fleece, mail them to my home for receipt by April 20, 2012.
6. UPS and FED EX will deliver to my residence.
7. Post Office delivery will require pick up.

**Mailed fleeces must be received no later than April 20, 2011**

Post show mail back service available for 12.00 per fleece. If you wish to show your fleeces at PAOBA we have made special arrangements to transport them at no additional cost. Please email any questions to [Judy@PerfectPeaceAlpacas.com](mailto:Judy@PerfectPeaceAlpacas.com).

FOR MORE COST EFFECTIVE RETURN SHIPPING you can provide your own postage:

- a) Please be sure to include your tags **INSIDE THE BOX** with your fleeces.
- b) When you take your fleeces to UPS, FED EX or POST OFFICE for weighing and shipping, purchase return postage (adding a few ounces for your ribbons!)
- c) Please place it in an envelope along with a return address label.
- d) The day after the show, all fleeces will be shipped to their next destination. If your fleece is going to another fleece show instead of back to your home, make sure your label has that address on it.
- e) Fleeces will be shipped out the Monday after the show.
- f) Please note: If you are missing a return address label or return postage, your fleece will not get mailed on the first Monday after the show.

Optional Fleece Awards for Suri & Huacaya:

**NEW: FLEECE PRODUCTION CLASSES:**

Get of Sire, Produce of Dam

Produce of Dam: Requires TWO progeny fleeces from the same Dam.

ARI of Dam must be submitted. She will be the actual entrant for this competition.

Get of Sire: Requires THREE progeny fleeces from the same Sire.

ARI of Sire must be submitted. He will be the actual entrant for this competition.

**Unclaimed fleece(s) will be given to AFCNA**

**Fleeces must be left on display until 1 pm on Sunday, April 29, 2012**
